



Brick Blending Disclaimer

At Metro Brick & Stone, we are committed to helping you achieve a consistent and harmonious blend of brick throughout your home. To ensure the best results, your mason must blend bricks from at least five cubes simultaneously—not just five straps, but five full cubes.

Due to the nature of brick manufacturing and packaging, color variations can occur within individual straps. This means that one strap may contain more of a particular color, while another may lack it entirely. If your mason uses a single strap at a time, it can result in an uneven and spotty appearance across the wall.

Correcting this issue after installation is both difficult and costly, often requiring either the removal and reinstallation of the brick or the services of a color correction expert to stain the brick. To avoid this, masons should use a full-size wheelbarrow, loading it with bricks from at least five different cubes, and periodically step back to assess their work for consistency.

Please note that once the brick is installed, Metro Brick & Stone cannot take responsibility for any color inconsistencies or other issues such as excessive chippage, warpage, incorrect color, lime pops, or size discrepancies. We urge you to address any concerns before the brick is installed so we can assist in resolving them promptly.
