



## **Guidelines for Installing Thin Used Antique Brick**

1. **\*\*Identify the Correct Face Side: \*\*** Ensure you distinguish between the face and the sawn back side of the brick. The correct face will feature a fired clay surface with remnants of used mortar, typically displaying variegated colors, some with texture or paint.
2. **\*\*Achieve a Uniform Blend: \*\*** Always draw brick from multiple sleeves simultaneously to achieve a well-blended appearance.
3. **\*\*Clean the Bricks Thoroughly: \*\*** Wash each brick on both sides before installation. Although the bricks undergo rinsing after cutting, some dust may remain.
4. **\*\*Plan Your Layout: \*\*** Arrange the bricks on the floor according to how you'd like the colors to blend on the wall. Instruct your installer to follow this pattern.
5. **\*\*Utilize Broken Brick: \*\*** Use any broken brick from the shipment for end cuts. Since used bricks may arrive with a few broken pieces, we include extras to ensure you have sufficient material. These broken bricks are still functional.
6. **\*\*Antique Brick Uniqueness: \*\*** Our used antique brick are over 125 years old and sourced from buildings slated for demolition. Each building's bricks are unique, and once sold, we move on to the next structure. Due to this variability, the photos on our website are representative but not exact. While we strive to match the images, variations between batches are inherent.
7. **\*\*Size and Color Variations: \*\*** All brick sizes are approximate, and color variations occur naturally due to the composition of the clays. The use of brick constitutes acceptance of these characteristics.
8. **\*\*Lead Paint Warning: \*\*** Used bricks may contain lead paint.
9. **\*\*Hand-Cut Brick Characteristics: \*\*** As bricks are hand-cut, some thickness variations and wedging are to be expected.
